COVID-19 Rules and Guidelines

These rules and guidelines are subjected to change at any time.

Version 1.0 – 6-1-2020

If you or anyone in your family has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days – OR- has symptoms of COVID-19, including dry cough, shortness of breath, fever and/or chills, loss of taste or smell – you are not permitted to enter the Hummelstown Swim Club. Please help to keep everyone in our community safe.

Face Masks and Coverings

Everyone over the age of 2 **MUST** have a mask.

Masks can be purchased at the desk for \$1.00 if you forget yours.

Masks need to be worn when entering and exiting the facility.

Masks need to be worn when in our common areas (bathrooms, concession stand, or walking around facility).

We recommend that you wear your masks when you are not actively swimming for your safety and all that are at the facility.

Masks **should not** be worn in any of the pools. This is an increase risk.

If at any time, while you are wearing your mask, you feel nauseous or light headed, please remove your mask and keep your distance.

Social Distancing

Family groups from the same household are permitted to congregate together, but these individual groups must maintain the 6' social distancing protocols from other groups and individuals.

Attendance and Capacity

A capacity limitation will be in place to allow for adequate social distancing. The current capacity for the pool will be 265 (this can change if and when the guidelines change for the state). The pool will operate under normal hours.

Guest

Currently, for the next several weeks, we will not be allowing members to bring in guests. We will post at the pool/website once guests will be allowed.

Restrooms

Masks are required! Our restrooms are large enough to have 2 people at a time. If you enter the restroom and see 2 occupants, please wait outside the door and wait until another person leaves. There will be markings on the deck. Main restrooms will be closed for a short period of time for cleaning, while they are being cleaned you will be able to use the restroom in the pavilions.

The best way to stay safe in our bathrooms are these steps that you already know... Enter the restroom, touch as little as possible, don't touch your face and wash your hands. When you leave, our doors push open, so please use your elbow to open the door.

Concession Stand

Masks are required!

The concession stand will be open with limited items to start with. There will be marking on the deck for social distancing. The water fountain will not be used this summer. We will not be filling personal cups with ice, you will be given a cup of ice if you need one.

Slide/Dives

You will be able to use the slide/dives. Handrails will be wiped down through out the day. There will be markings on the deck/grass for social distancing.

Recreation Area/Playground

Currently the rec area and playground will be closed, this also goes for the ping pong room. The pool basketball will also not be in use this summer.

Pavilions

Currently we will not be renting the pavilions out.

Umbrellas/goggles/noodles

The club will NOT supply or lend any items out. If you would like to have any of these items, you MUST bring them with you and take them with you when you leave. We also recommend that you DO NOT share your items with other non-household groups or accept the use of items from other groups.
